

Cockroach Treatment Preparation Sheet / Bait & Spray Treatment

In cockroach control, sanitation is essential. The following steps must be taken before we will perform a cockroach treatment. Items That Must Be Completed Prior To Our Arrival:

- Clean kitchen thoroughly, including floor, stove, range hood, and counter tops. Clean inside and outside of dishwasher. Pull out refrigerator, stove, etc. and clean behind and underneath. Crumbs from toasters and kitchen grease should be kept clean. All cleaning should be done before and after treatment. Remove food sources aggressively for these pests.
- Cabinets, under sink, and drawers should be cleaned and empty. Wash cabinets inside and out, wipe out drawers with damp rag. Kitchen and bathrooms if active in both should be empty
- Pick up and remove trash and recycling inside. If possible make baseboards visible throughout entire home or apartment. Please move personal items and furniture 6 to 12 inches away from walls as much as possible.
- Keep Kitchen clean and dry as the bait and spray work best with no other food sources and water. Roaches are very dependent on water so plugging drains is helpful in control.
- In roach control, sanitation is essential. Do not leave empty milk or beverage bottles inside. Keep areas under and behind stoves and refrigerators clean. Do not allow food and garbage or recycling to accumulate in areas where roaches feed or hide. Pet food should be stored in sealed containers.
- It is normal to see roaches for several days even weeks after the treatment. It may take this time for roaches hiding in inaccessible areas to contact control treatments.
- Please have children and animals away from treatment areas for 4 to 5 hours to let it dry. Once dry it is safe for both. If you have any questions before or after the treatment call 519-661-6832
